

# Additional COVID-19 Vaccine for People with Weakened Immune Systems

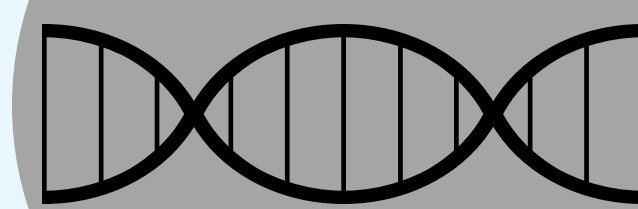


CDC recommends that people who are moderately to severely immunocompromised (have a weakened immune system) receive **3 doses of an mRNA COVID-19 Vaccine** (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna) rather than the 2 doses recommended for other people.

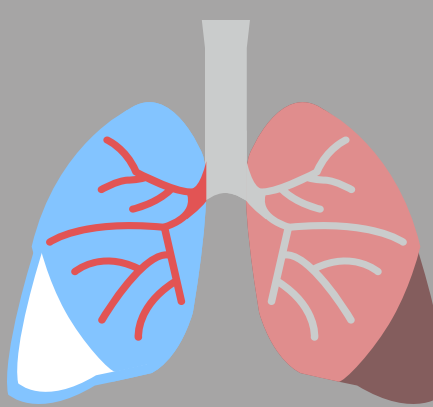
**This includes people who have:**



Been receiving active **cancer treatment** for tumors or cancers of the blood



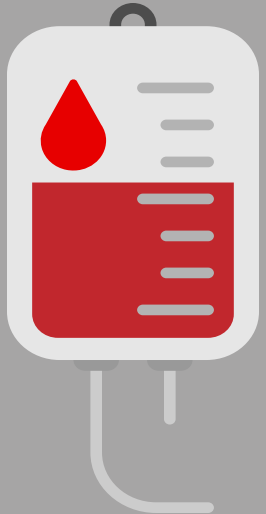
Moderate or severe **primary immunodeficiency** (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)



Received an **organ transplant** and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system



Advanced or untreated **HIV infection**



Received a **stem cell transplant** within past 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system



Active treatment with **high-dose corticosteroids** or other drugs that may suppress immune response

***Talk to your health care provider about your medical condition, and if getting an additional dose is right for you.***
