Weakened Immune Systems









CDC recommends that people who are moderately to severely immunocompromised (have a weakened immune system) receive 3 doses of an mRNA COVID-19 Vaccine (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna) rather than the 2 doses recommended for other people.


This includes people who have:



Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood




Moderate or severe **primary immunodeficiency** (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)




Received an **organ transplant** and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system



Advanced or untreated HIV infection



Received a **stem cell transplant** within past 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system



Active treatment with **high-dose corticosteroids** or other drugs that may suppress immune response
