A brief history of the HGEF may be of interest for you. In 1996 a parent donated \$5000 for the specific purpose of forming a Foundation to benefit the local Greenwich school and its community. After incorporation the Board suggested an auction in combination with a talent program to enhance community participation while bringing awareness of and support for the newly formed Foundation. And so Ye Greate Street, Live was born in March 2000! This event grew and evolved through the years but was cancelled abruptly in 2020 with the declaration of a world-wide pandemic - COVID-19!

In consideration for the safety of everyone supporting Ye Greate Street, Live the Board of the Historic Greenwich Education Foundation decided to cancel this event in 2021 and now again in 2022! However, the Historic Greenwich Education Foundation, Inc. continues to provide extraordinary opportunities, events, and equipment to the Greenwich Stow Creek Partnership Schools. The HGEF continues to offer scholarship money for eligible high school seniors. In 2022 the HGEF approved funds to repair the playground equipment.

The HGEF always needs your help in sustaining the work it does. It is only with your support the HGEF will thrive and provide opportunities for the children and the Greenwich Stow Creek Partnership Schools. The Foundation Board meets quarterly to discuss the possibilities and of course the possibility of hosting another Ye Greate Street, Live event safely in the future.
